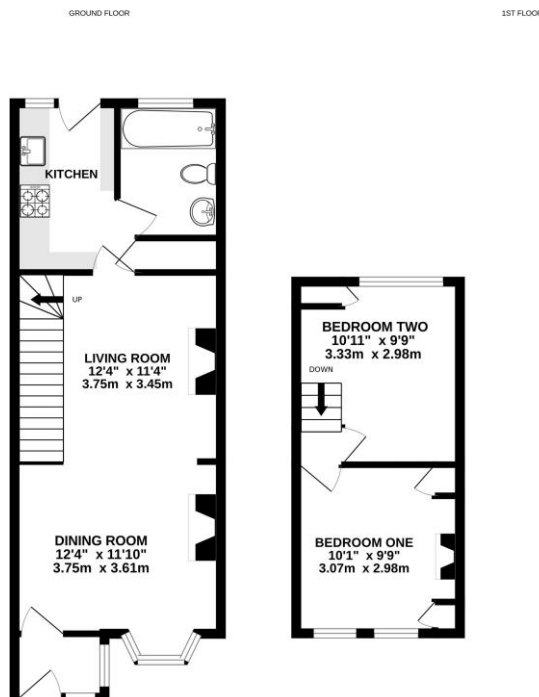
Description
