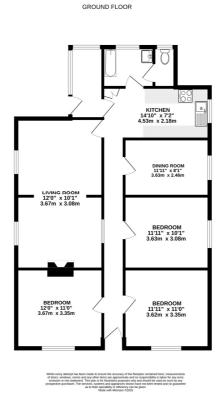
Description
