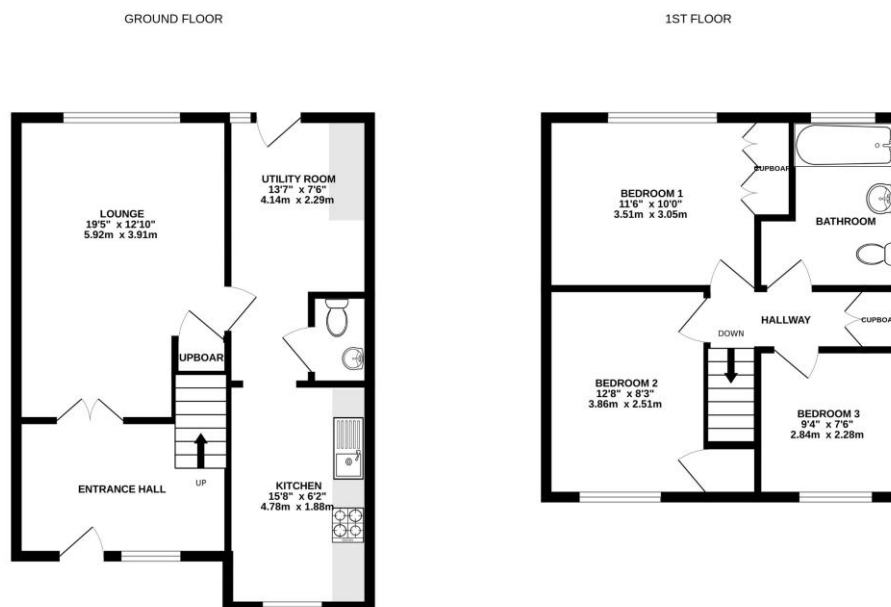
Description
